Thematic studies Paper 2:Religion and conflict, Religion and medicine, Religious expression and Religion and state from Christianity and Islam

Written exam: 1 hour 45 minutes paper 1 – and Written exam: 1 hour 45 minutes paper 2 96marks for both papers (plus 5 marks for SPAG)
