

KWA WJEC French GCSE – Linear Examination **Two Year Course** Examination 2017

Course Components: Two controlled assessments (Unit 2 and Unit 4) and two final exam papers (Unit 1 and Unit 3)

Controlled Assessments (Assessed at any point in Y10 and Y11)

UNIT 2- Speaking (Year 10 and Y11)

CONTROLLED ASSESSMENT

Communicating and interacting effectively in speech for a variety of purposes.

NOT TIERED

TWO TASKS - Total 40 marks (30 % OF GCSE)

1. **Structured Conversation- 4-5 minutes** (20 marks-15% of GCSE).
2. **Presentation- 2 -3 minutes followed by 3-4 minute question and answer section** (20 marks-15% of GCSE).

Concept map given to students two weeks before **structured conversation** controlled assessment. Students prepare task on their own. The teacher is not allowed to mark task during preparation time.

One of each task must be completed and marks submitted to the exam board by the 5th of May for moderation.

UNIT 4- Writing (Year 10 and Y11)

CONTROLLED ASSESSMENT

Communicating effectively in writing for a variety of purposes.

NOT TIERED

TWO TASKS - Total 40 marks (30 % OF GCSE)

1. **Writing Task 1- 200- 300 words for a grade C or above** (20 marks-15% of GCSE).
2. **Writing Task 2- 200- 300 words for a grade C or above** (20 marks-15% of GCSE).

Bullets points given to students two weeks before controlled assessment. Student prepare task on their own. The teacher is not allowed to mark tasks during preparation time.

Both tasks for every student is submitted to the exam board for marking by the 5th of May for moderation.

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Exam Component (Final Examination at the end of Y11)

LISTENING Unit 1

EXAMINATION ASSESSES:

Non-verbal responses and verbal responses in English to French listening tasks- Rubrics in English for the Foundation and Higher.

TIERED EXAMINATION

Foundation exam- 35 minutes + 5 minutes reading time / 40 marks (20 % of total GCSE)

Higher Paper - 45 minutes + 5 minutes reading time / 40 marks (20 % of total GCSE)

READING Unit 3

EXAMINATION ASSESSES:

Non-verbal responses and verbal responses in English to French listening tasks- Rubrics in English for the Foundation and Higher.

TIERED EXAMINATION

Foundation exam- 35 minutes / 40 marks (20 % of total GCSE)

Higher Paper - 45 minutes / 40 marks (20 % of total GCSE)
